LOCATION

Winifred Smith Hall, UC Irvine Campus (Bldg 710), Irvine, CA 92697

From North Orange County Area:

1. Take the 405 South to 73 South.
2. Exit University Drive.
3. Turn left on University Drive South.
4. At 4th stop light, turn right on Mesa Road.
5. At Athletics Drive (second driveway on the right), make a right turn and proceed to the parking garage.

From the San Diego Area:

1. Take the 405 North.
2. Exit at University Drive/Jeffrey Road.
3. Left on University Drive.
4. Left on Mesa Road, which is the first signal after Campus Drive.
5. At Athletics Drive (second driveway on the right), make a right turn and proceed to the parking garage.

From the Riverside Area:

1. Take the 91 West to 55 South.
2. From 55 South, take the 405 South to 73 South.
3. Exit University Drive.
4. Turn left on University Drive South.
5. At 4th stop light, turn right on Mesa Road.
6. At Athletics Drive (second driveway on the right), make a right turn and proceed to the parking garage.

MESA PARKING STRUCTURE 4004 Mesa Road, Irvine 92617

You may park on any level. However, we suggest you park on Level 3 for easy access to the pedestrian bridge located just to the right of the Level 3 elevator and staircase. Cross the arts bridge and go to the right after the Contemporary Arts Center. This will take you to Winifred Smith Hall, which is just after the Cyber A Cafe.
